Born deaf and unable to speak, Rae began making her vibrant color pencil drawings at age 50, when her mom signed her up for studio art classes for developmentally disabled adults at the Tierra del Sol Foundation in Sunland-Tujunga, California. Her works are based on fashion advertisements, transforming glossy photoshoots into eccentric yet captivating visions.
